Haddock Melanogrammus aeglefinus


Haddock is found in the North East Atlantic, from Iceland and the northern part of Norway to the Bay of Biscay.

This benthic fish lives from 40 to 300 metres in depth and is especially abundant between 80 and 200 metres.

Haddock acquires its sexual maturity between 2 and 5 years old and its longevity is estimated at 14 years.




Concave and convex sides of the otolith





High speed diamond saw

Reading thin otolith section Distal region Nucleus Proximal region




Age estimate is obtained after counting translucent increments





All exhibited otoliths have been sampled during the first half of the year.

All observations have been realized under transmitted light.



Focus on preferential area may be necessary to estimate fish age, in case of large otoliths.
