	Shipping	Merchant shipping and shipping management; Short sea shipping; Chartering-out; Cruise and ferry services; Ocean towage.
Shipbuilding	Seagoing vessels	Merchant ships; Fishing vessels Ocean-going tugs, workboats, supply ships, etc.; Floating sections.
	Repair and conversion	Repair and conversion of seagoing vessels.
	Naval ships	New building and repair of naval ships.
	Inland vessels	Inland barges; Inland and harbour tugs; Inland workboats, supply ships, etc.; Repair; Floating sections; Dry docks.
	Scrapping	All ship scrapping and recycling
	Offshore supply	Seismic research; Construction, installation and conversion of platforms, storage vessels and equipment; Drilling; Offshore-related transport, engineering, communication, consultancy and other support.
	Inland shipping	Inland shipping and ship management; Chartering-out; Inland cruises and ferries; Harbour and river towage; Freighting (no inland terminal).
Maritime works	Cables and pipelines	Nautical cable and pipeline works for offshore, telecommunications, etc.
	Dredging and other works	Dredging; River works; Construction of dykes, harbours and canals; Support vessels; Sand transport.
	Seaports and related services	Cargo handling; Shipping related storage, agency, maritime logistics and expedition; Port authorities; Pilotage.
	Fishing	Maritime fishing; Professional inland fishing; Shellfish production.
Recreation	Recreational vessels	Yacht construction; Sporting, sailing and rowing boats; Canoes; Inflatable boats; Repair; Floating sections.

	Recreational services	Yacht chartering and renting; Marinas; Inland yacht basins; Supporting services concerning the construction of, and trade in, recreational vessels; Yachting-related training and trade.
Maritime services	R&D and education	Research and development; Consultancy; Nautical training and education.
	Classification and inspection	Classification societies; Sampling; Laboratories.
	Support services	Bunkering; Ship supply; Rescue; Diving; Maritime insurance, financing, brokerage, law and medical services; Crewing; Maritime associations; Maritime government services.
Maritime equipment		Manufacturing of, and wholesale trade in, maritime equipment.
