


Figure B1 – Distributions of acoustic detections of small pelagic fishes smaller than 10 cm in the surface layer (a) and deep layer (b).




Figure B2 – Distributions of acoustic detections of small pelagic fishes between 10 and 20 cm long in the surface layer (a) and deep layer (b).




Figure B3 – Distributions of acoustic detections of small pelagic fishes between 20 and 30 cm long in the surface layer (a) and deep layer (b).




Figure B4 – Distributions of acoustic detections of small pelagic fishes larger than 30 cm in the surface layer (a) and deep layer (b).


